If you've been applying for a mortgage, frequent checks into your credit by several lenders over a short period can drop credit scores as much as 50 to 100 points. Thomas Martin of the National Mortgage Complaint Center recommends that you get your credit score and provide it to potential lenders, rather than allow them to check your score. To raise your score, pay off balances on credit cards at least two months before applying for a loan. Unpaid parking tickets, overdue library books and other past due bills can also hurt your score.
